In 2014, Laura was selected as the Australian Youth Representative to the United Nations, the only role of its kind in the country. Laura has also undertaken a pro bono secondment to the Women's Legal Centre ACT and has previously volunteered with the Asylum Seeker Resource Centre in Melbourne and Human Rights First in New York, assisting asylum seekers and refugees to seek protection.

While at Kilbreda, Laura aspired to work for the United Nations (UN). Since graduating she has gained experience with various UN agencies; including as a consultant for the UN High Commissioner for Refugees in Geneva and as a speaker at both the UN Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation's Global Citizenship Education Forum in Paris and the World Education Forum in South Korea.
